1 INTRODUCTION AND SCOPE

This Digital Privacy and Cookies Policy ("Policy") applies to your interaction with SFA at any online or mobile Website that we own and control ("Website"). In addition to the terms of this Policy, you agree to the [Terms and Conditions](#) of the SFA website which is posted on the SFA website.

By using this Website, you consent to this Policy, including your consent to our use and disclosure of information about you in the manner described in this Policy.

3 TYPES OF INFORMATION

Information that we may collect about you through online interaction includes information that you input, such as your name, address, email address and other contact information. Other Information we may collect online, is any information other than personal information that does not reveal your specific identity or does not directly relate to an individual, such as browser information, information collected through cookies, pixel tags and other technologies. We may also gather additional information, such as the type of device and browser you are using, the IP address of your device, information about your device's operating system, and additional information associated with your device. We may also gather information collected through cookies, tags, and other technologies.

4 USING INFORMATION

We will use any information we gather in a variety of ways responding to your requests and communicating with you and complying with and enforcing applicable legal requirements.

5 ABOUT "COOKIES" AND AD CHOICES ON THIRD PARTY SITES

Cookies are pieces of data stored on your device. Browser cookies are assigned by a web server to the browser on your device. When you return to a Website you have visited before, your browser gives this data back to the server. We use "Google Analytics" in order to collect information about the use of this Website. Google Analytics is a service that collects information such as how often users visit the Website, what pages are visited and what other websites users visited before navigating to this Website. Google Analytics does not collect your name or other identifying information, but instead, only collects the IP address used by you when visiting this Website. Your IP address will only be used by us for the purpose of improving this Website and is never combined with personally identifiable information.

When visiting our Website, Google Analytics places a cookie on your web browser in order to identify you as a unique user the next time you visit, and that cookie can only be used by Google. Google's ability to use and share information collected by Google Analytics is limited by the [Google Analytics Terms of Use](#) as well as the [Google Privacy Policy](#).
